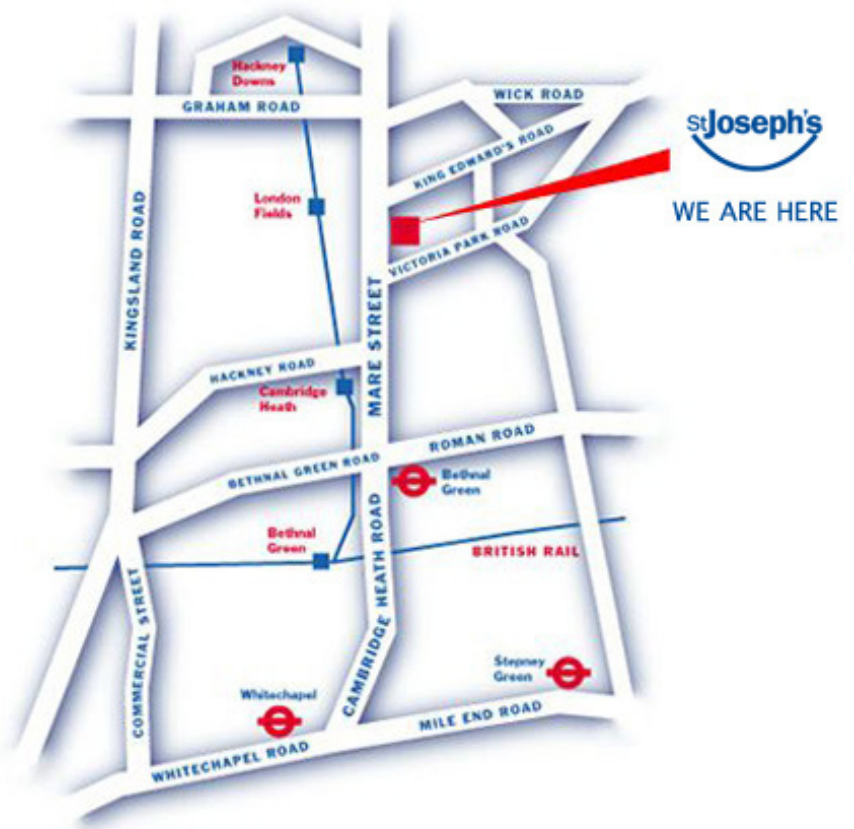
BUS: The following buses pass the gate: 26 - 48 - 55 - 106 - 254 and D6

TUBE: Central Line to Bethnal Green, and then by bus (106 - 253 - D6) or 15 minutes' walk from the station.

District Line to Whitechapel and then by bus (254 - 106) from outside the station.

RAIL: The nearest station is London Fields which provides onward connections to Liverpool Street, Walthamstow, Chingford and beyond.

Look out for NCPC representatives with balloons at Bethnal Green station. They will show you which bus stop to go to and where to alight for St Joseph's.
